# About the programs

- **1-Year program at UCSC Silicon Valley** (University of California, Bay Area Campus)
  - It's for MCA, MBA, M.Tech Or 4<sup>th</sup> year engineering students, (3+1), undergrad students can complete 6 semesters in India and earn the rest of 30 or 40 credits in the US
- **Certificate Programs** in CS, Data Science, AI and Machine learning, Business Management, Product Management, and Program management certificates and many others
  - An articulation agreement with Notre Dame de Namur's MBA program and Master's in Technology Management program after students complete the Business Administration certificate.
  - Opportunity to apply for master's programs in the US Universities
- **Units per quarter:** 12 (with an option for reduced course load in the final/3rd quarter)
- **Units to complete certificate program:** 14-19 units
- **Units taken in 9-month program:** 30 units
  - *\*\*International students are required to take 12 units per quarter to stay in status for their F-1 visa, in that time students interested in Technology Certificates could complete 2 certificate programs (14 units each)*
- **Unpaid Internships:** UC system has partner companies that will hire unpaid interns to experience work at a tech company in Silicon Valley, students can earn 3 units per quarter, and intern for a minimum of 90 hours per quarter and maximum of 200 hours per quarter (no more that 20 hours per week)
- **1 year of OPT work authorization:** After 9 months of study and completion of a certificate program students can apply
- **Workshops:** interview skills prep, resume assistance, public speaking skills, presentations, leadership skills, soft skills, LinkedIn, and industry specific workshops
